# **CLUB OVERVIEWS**

#### Gardening Club - Year 3-6

Our main area for gardening is the school's allotment area where we have had a great selection of vegetables in the past. We have some new fruit areas too and so are hoping for some good harvests this year. The gardeners will also take ownership of some other areas within the school grounds, helping to keep our school looking beautiful, tidy and colourful. Previous activities have included, seed planting, weeding, garden design and wreath making using items foraged on school grounds. We try and stay outside as much as we can and so the gardeners are invited to bring some waterproof clothes for each session.

## Ultimate Frisbee - Year 3-6

A non-contact team sport played with a flying disc frisbee. Two teams compete on a playing field with an end zone at each end. Each team defends one end zone. They score a goal if one of their players catches the disc in the opposite end zone.

#### Watercolour Painting Club - Year 1-2

A fun club to introduce young artists to the basics of watercolour painting, learning techniques and ideas through simple projects.

# Cookery Club - Year 2-6

Children will learn to cook a variety of sweet and savoury treats, learning new skills and recipes over the weeks.

#### Rounders - Year 3-6

The children will learn the rules and skills required for rounders and have fun playing it!

#### Film Club - Year 1-2

For children interested in watching films and who want to know a little more about how they are made. Each week we will be watching a film (sometimes with a little snack) and talking about what we liked, what we didn't like and what we would improve.

## Young Playwrights - Year 3-6 - (Children must register for the full summer term)

Come and enjoy a mixture of games, mindfulness, and lots of laughter as you are guided through creating your own story. Each week we build on characters, plot and how to push your ideas so they are full of drama. Then we are ready to work together to bring your play to life. Great for children who are natural writers and those who need a helping hand. We are dyslexia friendly in our approach and all ability levels can take part with ease. Develop your imagination, grow in confidence, play with stories... and most importantly join in 'biscuit circle' - the yummiest way to share your ideas.

## Football - Year 2-4

Children will learn and practise basic football skills and drills and take part in match play to help develop their understanding of the game.

## Quiz Club - Year 3-6

Quiz Club runs the largest National Championship for primary school aged children in the country. The quiz is presented live online by our professional Quizmaster and the children play using a device which the system converts to a handset. This enables children from schools across the country to be included, making it a unique after school experience for the players, with children teaming up with each other from around the UK.
