# **CLUB OVERVIEWS**

## Gardening Club - Year 3-6

Our main area for gardening is the school's allotment area where we have had a great selection of vegetables in the past. We have some new fruit areas too and so are hoping for some good harvests this year. The gardeners will also take ownership of some other areas within the school grounds, helping to keep our school looking beautiful, tidy and colourful. Previous activities have included, seed planting, weeding, garden design and wreath making using items foraged on school grounds. We try and stay outside as much as we can and so the gardeners are invited to bring some waterproof clothes for each session.

#### Chess Club - Year 4-6

Chess is fun, it can help improve concentration and develop logical reasoning. Not only can chess help develop self-confidence, but it can enhance reading, memory, language, and mathematical abilities; it fosters critical, creative, and original thinking. Children don't have to be able to play, just have an interest in the game.

#### Hama Beads - Year 1-2

Children will have the chance to use their creative flair to design and complete a variety of Hama bead projects.

### Cookery Club - Year 2-6

Children will learn to cook a variety of sweet and savoury treats, learning new skills and recipes over the weeks.

#### Film Club - Year 1-2

For children interested in watching films and who want to know a little more about how they are made. Each week we will be watching a film (sometimes with a little snack) and talking about what we liked, what we didn't like and what we would improve.

## Quiz Club - Year 3-6

Quiz Club runs the largest National Championship for primary school aged children in the country. The quiz is presented live online by our professional Quizmaster and the children play using a device which the system converts to a handset. This enables children from schools across the country to be included, making it a unique after school experience for the players, with children teaming up with each other from around the UK. ## Lego Club - Year 1-6

Children will be challenged as a team to make a different structure each week. They will use and develop teamwork and problem-solving skills to complete the task.

#### Computing Club - Year 3-6

Children will get the chance learn and practice a range of computer-based skills such as making stop motion animations, creating their own comics and programming games.

#### Textile Crafts - Year 3-6

The club offers a chance for children to learn textile-based crafts such as weaving, cross stitching and making rag rugs.

#### French Club - Year 1-2

This club gives children an introduction to the French language. Children will learn the basics of French through playing games and music.
