CLUB OVERVIEWS

Film Club - Year 1-2

For children interested in watching films and who want to know a little more about how they are made. Each week we will be watching a film (sometimes with a little snack) and talking about what we liked, what we didn't like and what we would improve.

Chess Club - Year 4-6

Chess is fun, it can help improve concentration and develop logical reasoning. Not only can chess help develop self-confidence, but it can enhance reading, memory, language, and mathematical abilities; it fosters critical, creative, and original thinking. Children don't have to be able to play, just have an interest in the game.

Hama Beads - Year 3-6

Children will have the chance to use their creative flair to design and complete a variety of Hama bead projects.

Young Playwrights - Year 3-6

Come and enjoy a mixture of games, mindfulness, and lots of laughter as you are guided through creating your own story. Each week we build on characters, plot and how to push your ideas so they are full of drama. Then we are ready to work together to bring your play to life. Great for children who are natural writers and those who need a helping hand. We are dyslexia friendly in our approach and all ability levels can take part with ease. Develop your imagination, grow in confidence, play with stories ... and most importantly join in 'biscuit circle' - the yummiest way to share your ideas. This club runs on specific dates across the whole Spring Term and is for 2 hours per session.

Cookery Club - Year 2-6

Children will learn to cook a variety of sweet and savoury treats, learning new skills and recipes over the weeks.

Quiz Club - Year 3-6

Quiz Club runs the largest National Championship for primary school aged children in the country. The quiz is presented live online by a professional Quizmaster and the children play using a device which the system converts to a handset. This enables children from schools across the country to be included, making it a unique after school experience for the players, with children teaming up with each other from around the UK. As well as the quizzes being fantastic fun, they are also highly educational and inspiring. In true Pub(less) Quiz style, Mrs Fulstow will provide the drinks and crisps!!

Lego Club - Year 1-6

Children will be challenged as a team to make a different structure each week. They will use and develop teamwork and problem-solving skills to complete the task.

Robot Club - Year 5-6

Children will be challenged to design, build and programme their very own robot.

French Club - Year 1-2

This club gives children an introduction to the French language. Children will learn the basics of French through playing games and music.

Digital Leaders - Year 1-2

For children interested in helping to maintain the ICT equipment, updating iPads and helping children with the computing skills. Children will get the chance to help with Esafety day and support the school with using our technology properly.

Flex Dance - Year 1-6

Following the success of our Flex Dance sessions in curriculum time in school, the Flex Dance team are offering an after school activity club. This club will run for 5 weeks (not 3 as with all of the other clubs this half term) and will be themed around both Hairspray the musical and street dance.
