**YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL VISIT TO EAST BARNBY OUTDOOR ACTIVITY CENTRE

Just a few last minute reminders for our trip to East Barnby next week, which all the children and staff are really looking forward to. Unfortunately Mrs Woodend injured her leg last weekend, resulting in severe ligament damage, and therefore is now unable to attend. She is extremely disappointed to be missing out on such a wonderful visit. Miss Partridge, our Educational Visits Co-ordinator and Year 2 teacher will now be accompanying us on the visit.

Please arrive no sooner than 8.40am and enter school through the car park via the hall entrance. Children should come dressed in clothes in preparation for their first activity on arrival (no jeans please!). Remember to ensure they have a waterproof coat in their day sack. The coach is leaving at 9.00am after registration and parents are welcome to stay to wave off their loved ones.

Make sure your child has all the essential items on the kit list so that he/she is fully prepared and ensure their bag/suitcase is clearly named. Your child can bring a maximum of £10 spending money for the tuck shop and souvenirs in a named envelope which should be handed to their group leader. Please indicate on the envelope what items your child wishes to purchase. Children may bring a book or notepad for the coach journey or simply enjoy the art of conversation!

Children are **not** allowed to bring mobile phones/electronic games/ipods/sweets/fizzy drinks. Cameras will not be required as all photographs will be taken by the group leaders. Following the trip each child will receive a CD containing photographs as a special memento.

Any medication, other than inhalers, should be given to the group leader. Please ensure that it is clearly labelled with your child's name, instructions for administering and a letter giving permission for it to be given. Remember to bring sufficient travel sickness pills for the return journey if required. Children suffering from asthma must carry their inhaler with them at all times.

The safety of our children is of paramount importance and we therefore expect the highest standards of responsible behaviour to ensure everyone has an enjoyable visit. Our expectations have been made very clear to the children and we know we can rely on your support in this matter. Hopefully it will not be necessary to contact any parent regarding concerns about behaviour whilst on the visit.

We anticipate returning back at school on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> October at approximately 4:00pm along with a bag full of memories and dirty washing! It promises to be a fantastic visit and I'm sure all the children and staff will have a wonderful time.
