Dear Parents,

The children in Year 2 will be doing their end of Key Stage 1 SATs during the last two weeks of next half term, Monday 13th May - Friday 24th May. Please could you make sure the children are not taken out of school during this period. The SATs are a statutory requirement, but we do not need to report on them, they just provide us with additional evidence to support our teacher assessment judgements at the end of the year.

The SATs are in reading and maths and will take place as part of normal classroom practice. Hopefully the children will not know that their learning is any different during these two weeks. In maths the children will do two papers: one arithmetic and one reasoning (problem solving and application). There are 2 papers in reading to assess the children's knowledge of a text. As part of their learning, the children are completing practice questions and papers in class so the layout of the papers will not come as a shock to them.

From now until the end of the SATs, children will be bringing home some practice questions to do with you based on the skills and concepts we have learnt so far. We will send maths one week and reading the following week. As mentioned, the children will be used to these types of questions and the homework will just be practice that they will be able to complete on their own. If you do need to give any support, please could you write on the sheets so that we are aware. The home learning the children have for now is also in line with the questions on the papers, and is practising the skills and concepts we have learnt so far.

If you have any questions or concerns, please speak with either of us.
