Welcome to EYFS

Welcome to Early Years! This letter explains our expectations and includes key information about routines and procedures.

Start and Finish Times

Children can be dropped off at the EYFS door on the main playground between 8.40am and 8.55am. Please collect at 3.10pm from the EYFS playground accessing through the EYFS gate off the main playground.

PE

Children should come to school dressed in their PE kit on Tuesday and Wednesday.

Independence

Please ensure all belongings are clearly labelled with your child's name and he/she is able to identify their own wellies. Every morning, children will be responsible for selecting their own lunch so please help by ensuring they know what the options are each day (menu on the website or on the noticeboard outside EYFS).

Home/School communication

Class Dojo is the best way to contact your child's class teacher for simple queries. For other issues or concerns, please arrange to see the class teacher or EYFS leader (Mrs Brammall) via the school office. For all SEND queries please contact SEND@epsch.co.uk.

If you have any written messages or return slips, please place them in the envelope in the box at drop off.

Waterproof and wellies

Please ensure all children have a waterproof top, bottoms and wellies in school every day.

Home Learning

Shortly your child will receive a Doodle Maths login to access an online app 'Doodle Maths'. It is our expectation that children go on the app every day and complete their 5 a day to help them become confident in the recall of number facts.

Home Reading

We would like you to read with your child every day. Each day, there will be a choice of library books for you to select to enjoy reading at home. These will be available under the EYFS canopy at pick up time. Over the next half term, your child will receive their first decodable reading book. These must be kept in their book bag everyday as they are read in school and changed weekly.

Healthy Eating

If your child brings a packed lunch, please keep items to a minimum as the children have limited time to eat their lunch. Please remember we do not allow sweets or fizzy drinks in school.

Allergen information - we are a nut free school and we have children who are anaphylactic so please be considerate of this at all times.
