### 'Decorative Pots'

At the Christmas fair, Year 2 will be running a 'Decorative Pint Pots Stall'.

Your child has brought home a plastic pint pot and a wealth of ideas as to what to do with it! The idea is that the children decorate and fill the pot, which is then used on the stall. All pots will be given a number, with the corresponding number placed in a tub, and for £2 people can pick out a number and win a pot. The pot therefore needs to be filled with something suitable for a prize.

Some ideas are .....

- Cut out or draw pictures of flowers, stick them to the outside of the pot and put seed packets / gardening gloves / a trowel etc inside
- Turn the pot upside down and turn it into a Dalek or Darth Vader and fill it with Dr Who or Star Wars goodies
- Turn the pot upside down and turn it into Minion and fill it with Minion goodies
- Turn the pot into a snowman and put a pair of gloves / scarf / hat / chocolate snowmen in it
- Cut out footballs or football players to stick on the outside and put football goodies in the pot, or a pair of football socks
- Make plaits out of wool and stick them to the sides of the pot, put a face on the front and fill the pot with hair accessories
- Turn the pot into a 'bathing pot' and fill it with bath bombs, bath bubbles and soap
- Stick sweet wrappers to the pot and fill it with sweets
- Put numbers on the outside and put a lottery ticket in the pot – someone has to win!

- Fill it with soil and plant a hyacinth bulb and put a ribbon round
- Decorate the outside with animal pictures and put animal goodies in
- Wrap a colouring picture round it and fill it with pencils, a rubber, a ruler

I am sure the children (and grown ups) can be more imaginative than me! There will be a prize for the most imaginative pint pot!

Please could you help and encourage your child to decorate and fill the pot and return it to school by the morning of the fair. If all 30 are returned, Year 2 will make £60!!
