

# BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL CLUB



Wrap around care for children in Nursery to Year 6



My name is Mrs Relph, I lead and manage the Before and After School Club here at Elloughton Primary School having 20 years' experience in primary education. Thank you for your interest in our Before and After School Club, I hope this leaflet will answer some of the questions you may have.

Our team at the Before and After School Club provide an excellent childcare facility to accommodate parents whose working commitments extend before and beyond the school day.

Our childcare setting is run by happy, enthusiastic and experienced staff who nurture and strive to make your child's time at the club an enjoyable addition to their school day. We are a happy and inclusive club where inspiring activities give children of all ages, from Nursery to Year 6, the opportunity to explore.

The staffing levels within the Before and After School Club helps us to:

- Give time and attention to each child
- Talk with the children about their interests and activities
- Help children to experience and benefit from the activities we provide
- Allow children to explore and be adventurous in their play

Our staff are always ready and willing to talk to you about your views or answer any questions you or your child may have.

## Our Before School Club Sessions

This session starts at 7:30am Monday to Friday and is held in the school hall. All children should arrive via the external hall door. We ask parents to bring their child to the hall door where they must be signed in.

We provide a nutritious, varied breakfast, all children can choose from unlimited cereals, yoghurts and delicious hot buttered toast with jam.

The session is organised so the children have the opportunity to explore a range of activities, including outdoor activity sessions.

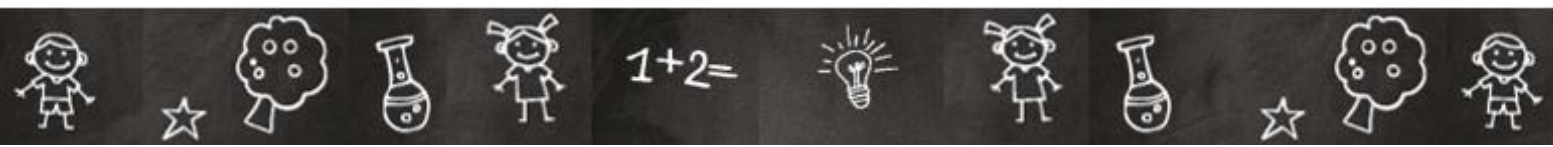
## Our After School Club Sessions

This session is also held in the school hall. It starts at the end of the school day and finishes at 6pm Monday to Thursday and 5:30pm on Friday. On arrival at the club the children are offered a tasty selection of fruit.

Here the children have the opportunity to relax and enjoy their time at the club through various activities centred around a weekly theme or topic. The children are also helped and encouraged to take part in small adult led activities and large group activities, exploring new interests and discovering new hobbies; helping to build new friendships and develop existing ones.

Outdoor activities contribute to the children's healthy physical development and the knowledge of the world around them. They have the opportunity to take part in outdoor child initiated and adult led activities, as well as those provided in the school hall.

The After School session provides children remaining after 4:30pm with a light teatime meal; fresh fruit is always available.





## Booking

Bookings for the Before and After School Club should be made online via the school website under the Parents Tab/Before and After School Club. Bookings and cancellations can be made up to one hour before the start of the session. All sessions must be booked and paid for in advance. We accept payment via PayPal, some childcare vouchers (please contact the school office to check if your vouchers are valid) and the government tax-free childcare scheme.
