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To secure a place for your child on any of the clubs listed above, please book and pay via Reach More Parents > Payments > Weduc Payments Purse Trips & Offers > Offers Available when clubs open for booking. You can check your purchases in the 'view transactions' section of your 'Payments Purse'.

All clubs, under Health & Safety, have a maximum limit set. Reach More Parents will count down as each place is booked. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis so prompt payment is essential to guarantee a place. Please do not send your child to a club unless you have paid.

In the event of bad weather, we will endeavour not to postpone outdoor sessions and conduct indoor activities/coaching sessions where possible. If a club is cancelled, we will reschedule the session, unless the club is run by an outside provider and no refund will be issued. All of the after school activity clubs run from the end of school and finish at 4:30pm unless it states otherwise, please collect your child from the school office for indoor clubs and from the gate at the end of the staff car park for outdoor clubs.

If you book your child onto any of our clubs, please remember to cancel any After School Club bookings you may have already made.

CLUB OVERVIEWS

Taskmaster Club - Year 3-6

Like the popular TV show, Taskmaster Club will give children the chance to take on a range of creative and physical activities, encouraging them to think outside the box and use their brains in a different way. Children will work in small groups competing to win the overall title of Elloughton Primary Taskmaster Champions.

Watercolour Painting Club - Year 5-6

A fun, and creative watercolour painting and sketch club where we will explore basic sketching techniques, observation, dimension and tonal skills, as well as watercolour painting techniques. Children will be encouraged to choose their own subject matter painting out in the school grounds when weather permits or from reference photos that children can bring from home if they wish or there will be a few to choose from.

OPAL Play Club - Reception - Year 6

Children are invited to come and explore our OPAL Play areas to swing, climb, build, dig and much more. They can use their creativity in play to have fun whilst developing their ability to problem solve, persevere and be a team player.

Cookery Club - Year 2-6

Children will learn to cook a variety of sweet and savoury treats, learning new skills and recipes over the weeks.

Quiz Club - Year 3-6

Quiz Club runs the largest National Championship for primary school aged children in the country. The quiz is presented live online by a professional Quizmaster and the children play using a device which the system converts to a handset. This enables children from schools across the country to be included, making it a unique after school experience for the players, with children teaming up with each other from around the UK. As well as the quizzes being fantastic fun, they are also highly educational and inspiring. In true Pub(less) Quiz style, Mrs Fulstow will provide the drinks and crisps!!

Playground Games - Year 1-2

Come along and enjoy a range of good old-fashioned team and solo playground games. Each week Mrs Callaghan will introduce children to games they will already know and love and some they have yet to discover.

Mini Greenthumb Gardening Club - Year 3-6

Our young gardeners will be very busy making our outdoor green areas look neat & tidy and looking after the school allotment.

Young Playwrights - Year 3-6

Come and enjoy a mixture of games, mindfulness, and lots of laughter as you are guided through creating your own story. Each week we build on characters, plot and how to push your ideas so they are full of drama. Then we are ready to work together to bring your play to life. Great for children who are natural writers and those who need a helping hand. We are dyslexia friendly in our approach and all ability levels can take part with ease. Develop your imagination, grow in confidence, play with stories... and most importantly join in 'biscuit circle' - the yummiest way to share your ideas. This club runs for 2 hours per session.

Rounders - Year 3-6

Children will enjoy some good outdoor team fun with this term's 'Rounders Club'. Our Learning Support Assistants will be hosting this club each week and welcome new or experienced players!

Epic Gameshows - Year 3-6

The ultimate team competition! Children will be split into two teams and each week will compete in these teams in a different 'epic gameshow'. Think 'Family Fortunes', 'Win, Lose or Draw' and 'Blockbusters'... which team will become the champions?

Football - Year 5-6

Children will learn and practise a range of football skills and drills and take part in matches to help develop their game play ability.

Netball - Year 3-6

Children will practise passes and other skills, learning new drills and practising game play in a variety of positions.

Football - Year 2-4

Children will learn and practise basic football skills and drills and take part in match play to help develop their understanding of the game.
