Working as a Musician

Music at Elloughton will provide opportunities for children to;

- Listen to, review and evaluate music across a range of historical periods, genres, styles and traditions, including the works of the great composers and musicians.
- Perform, sing and use their voices to create and compose music on their own and with others.
- Understand and explore how music is created, produced and communicated.
- Learn a musical instrument.
- Use and understand staff and other musical notations.
- Use technology to create and record music.
