Dear Parents/Carers

As part of our ongoing review of COVID practices, we have discussed the use of PE kits; changing for PE along with health and hygiene. We feel that Year 5/6 children, who are much quicker at changing than younger pupils, are at a stage where they become very hot and sweaty during PE lessons and therefore it is important to revert to changing for PE. Changing and organising their belongings are also essential skills for helping them to prepare for the transition to secondary school and is also an important step towards being more independent. Pupils will change in their classrooms with teachers present in the room, the rooms will be organised so that girls and boys can change in different areas of the room as we have done in previous years.

In order to keep PE time to its maximum changing will only happen once per day meaning pupils will either arrive in PE kit or go home in PE kit. Below is a timetable for when each class needs to wear their PE kit or school uniform. This can be cut out and put where your child can see it to help organise themselves.
