Dear Parents/Carers

Thursday 1st July 2021 9.00-3.30pm - Year 5/6 Eden Camp Trip

All of Year 5/6 will be visiting Eden Camp to support their history work.

Wednesday 7th July 2021 1:45pm to 3:15pm - 'Rock Bottom' Rehearsal (For other family members) (tbc)

The children will be performing their dress rehearsal of 'Rock Bottom' in the school hall and extended family members (other than parents e.g. Grandparents, aunties, uncles etc.) will be invited to attend, subject to COVID restrictions.
